**Mission**

The mission of Jung Kim's Before & After School Enrichment Program (BASEP) is to help students develop a solid foundation for their future through academic success and Taekwondo. Our program gives students one on one help with after school work while also helping in their physical development. Taekwondo gives students the opportunity to improve their focus and self-esteem. It also demonstrates a core value that respect for others is respect for self.

**Program Overview**

BASEP is a martial arts based program. It is designed to support the student in learning school academics and Taekwondo, with an emphasis on improving self-confidence, concentration skills and respect. Our Taekwondo van will transport children between their schools and Jung Kim's Martial Arts Academy. Students will attend Taekwondo classes two to three times per week. When not attending classes students will be able to participate in activities in BASEP. There will be homework time for students upon arriving at BASEP. If the student doesn't have homework they are required to have a book to read. After homework time students may continue to study or participate in the craft or exploration of the day.

**After School Program ends at 6:30pm.**

**Belt Testing**

During the year students will have the opportunity to belt test. In order to test students must satisfactorily demonstrate their knowledge of Jung Kim's Martial Arts curriculum for their current belt level. Taking the belt test allows the student to progress to the next belt level and learn new curriculum. The belt test fee is \$50. The students are required to attend two TKD classes per week (and two sparring classes per month for red belts and higher) in order to participate in belt testing, so it is important they participate and turn in their attendance cards.
